LIEUTENANT, JUNIOR GRADE, FRANKLIN WILLIAM GOGINS, JR.
UNITED STATES NAVAL RESERVE

for service as set forth in the following

CITATION:

"For heroism and extraordinary achievement in aerial flight while serving in Patrol Bombing Squadron **TWENTY FIVE**, during operations against enemy Japanese forces in the Pacific War Area from December 18, 1944, to February 8, 1945. Completing his twentieth flight during this period, Lieutenant, Junior Grade, (then Ensign) Gogins contributed materially to the success of his squadron. His airmanship, courage and devotion to duty in the face of grave hazards were in keeping with the highest traditions of the United States Naval Service."
